Our Annual Hunter Shoot is upon us. It is a fun shoot attended by Swiss Rifle Club members, hunters, and other wanna-be experts trying out their marksmanship at one of the targets. There are two practice shots allowed! You get three shots per target. The target distance is 300m. For the first time this year, we will have 2 classes of shooters.

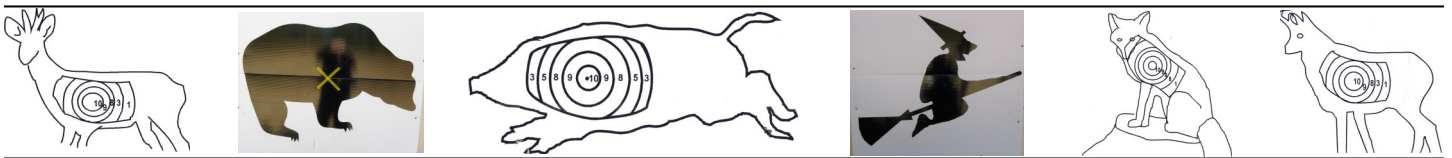
A Class = Any open sight (iron sights) rifle. (No scopes)

This class is for the true wannabe expert Swiss hunter. They still hunt with open sights in Switzerland today.

B Class = Rifles with scopes (Bring your hunting rifle)

This class is for the less adventure seeking hunters.

Below are the targets you are expected to score on.



General Rules

1. Description

The competition consists of 5 different animals and a witch target as follows:

- Chamois - 3 shots (morning)
- Boar - 3 shots (morning)
- Bear - 3 shots (morning)

- Deer - 3 shots (afternoon)
- Fox - 3 shots (afternoon)
- Witch - 3 shots (afternoon)

You are allowed 2 practice shots ONLY at any time of your choosing.

2. Costs (include lunch consisting of soup and a bun, dinner with desert & coffee, every shooter will receive a Meat Prize pre pared by Valbella Gourmet Foods in Canmore)

3. Repeats

Repeats can be shot as time permits but only after all shooters have completed their 1st series.

4. Scoring

The highest scores obtained (main or repeat) on each target will be added together to determine the winner.

5. Shooting Schedule

10:00 to 12:30 Range open (Chamois, Boar & Bear)

12:30 to 13:00 Lunch break

13:00 to 16:00 Range Open (Deer, Fox & Witch)
